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RECIPROCAL SHIPMENTS OF WINE

THE REGISTRATION AND NOTIFICATION PROCEDURES CONTAINED HEREIN APPLIES ONLY TO THE COUNTY OF HAWAII , COUNTY OF MAUI and THE COUNTY OF KAUAI.

General Information: Pursuant to Act 58, SLH2001, effective July 1, 2001 direct shipments of wine into the State of Hawaii shall be permitted to the holder of a valid wine manufacturer's license issued by another state whose laws allow an equal reciprocal shipping privilege to wine manufacturers in the State of Hawaii. Wineries may ship wines in quantities not to exceed two cases of wine, each case not being more than 9 liters, of its own manufacture per calendar year to a Hawaii resident, 21 years of age or older.

Prior to doing business in the State of Hawaii, wineries located in reciprocal states shall be required to register with each of the four county liquor authorities. Call the City and County of Honolulu Liquor Commission for its procedures. (Recommendation: Your invoice should require the consumer to identify the county in which he or she resides.)

NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

WINERIES SHALL FILE A SHIPPING INVOICE FOR EACH DELIVERY TO THE APPROPRIATE DEPARTMENT OF LIQUOR CONTROL. THE INVOICE SHALL:

1. BE FILED WITHIN 7 DAYS OF SHIPMENT
2. CONTAIN THE NAME, ADDRESS, DATE OF BIRTH OF THE CONSUMER
3. CONTAIN THE BRAND, VALUE AND QUANTITY (liters)

ACT 58 (SLH2001)
Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the holder of a license to manufacture wine in another state that affords holders of a class 1 license to manufacture wine under section 281-31 an equal reciprocal shipping privilege, may ship for personal use and not for resale not more than two cases of wine of its own manufacture per year, with each case containing not more than nine liters, to any resident twenty-one years of age or older. Out-of-state wine manufacturers that are authorized to ship wine under this section shall submit, to the appropriate liquor commission, a shipping invoice for each delivery into this state. Delivery of a shipment into this state shall not constitute a sale in this state.
